1 Section 1. Section 321.34, subsection 8A, unnumbered
2 paragraph 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under
4 section 321.109, subsection 1, light delivery truck, panel
5 delivery truck, motorcycle, trailer, or pickup who was a
6 prisoner of war during the Second World War at any time
7 between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, the Korean
8 Conflict at any time between June 25, 1950, and January 31,
9 1955, or the Vietnam Conflict at any time between August 5,
10 1964, and June 30, 1973, all dates inclusive, may, upon
11 written application to the department, order only one set of
12 special registration plates with an ex-prisoner of war
13 processed emblem. A sole proprietorship that owns a motor
14 vehicle described in this subsection may apply for one set of
15 the special plates if the sole proprietor of the business
16 meets the prisoner of war requirements of this subsection and
17 the sole proprietor has not been issued the special plates as
18 an individual under this subsection. The emblem shall be
19 designed by the department in cooperation with the adjutant
20 general and shall signify that the owner was a prisoner of war
21 as described in this subsection. The application is subject
22 to approval by the department, in consultation with the
23 adjutant general. The special plates shall be issued at no
24 charge and are subject to an annual registration fee of
25 fifteen dollars. The county treasurer shall validate the
26 special plates in the same manner as regular registration
27 plates are validated under this section.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill allows a sole proprietorship that owns a motor
30 vehicle to obtain one set of ex-prisoner of war special motor
31 vehicle registration plates for that vehicle if the sole
32 proprietor was a prisoner of war during the Second World War
33 at any time between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946,
34 the Korean Conflict at any time between June 25, 1950, and
35 January 31, 1955, or the Vietnam Conflict at any time between

1 August 5, 1964, and June 30, 1973.
