A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the designation of model communities in
2 projects, pilot projects, or similar initiatives undertaken by
3 the governor or the executive branch and providing effective
4 and applicability dates.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 7.18 MODEL COMMUNITY PROJECTS.

2 1. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise
3 suggests, "community" means a city, county, or any combination
4 of cities and counties.

5 2. During any project, pilot project, or similar
6 initiative undertaken by the governor or the executive branch
7 which includes the designation of a model community in the
8 state, the approval of all of the following entities must be
9 obtained by a simple majority vote prior to the granting of an
10 official model community designation and prior to any state
11 financial support being disbursed to any person under the
12 project, pilot project, or similar initiative:

13 a. The city council of any city included in a proposed
14 model community.

15 b. The county board of supervisors of a county included in
16 a proposed model community.

17 c. Each school board of a school district serving students
18 in a proposed model community.

19 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.

20 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect
21 upon enactment and is retroactively applicable to July 1,
22 2000.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill provides that, during any project, pilot project,
25 or similar initiative undertaken by the governor or the
26 executive branch which includes the designation of a model
27 community in the state, any city council, county board of
28 supervisors, or school district included in the proposed model
29 community designation must approve of the designation by a
30 simple majority vote prior to an official model community
31 designation and prior to any state financial support being
32 disbursed to a person under the project, pilot project, or
33 similar initiative.

34 The bill takes effect upon enactment and is retroactively
35 applicable to July 1, 2000.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DESIGNATION OF MODEL COMMUNITIES IN PROJECTS, PILOT PROJECTS, OR SIMILAR INITIATIVES UNDERTAKEN BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 7.18 MODEL COMMUNITY PROJECTS.

1. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise suggests, "community" means a city, county, or any combination of cities and counties.

2. During any project, pilot project, or similar initiative undertaken by the governor or the executive branch which includes the designation of a model community in the state, the approval of all of the following entities must be obtained by a simple majority vote prior to the granting of an official model community designation and prior to any state financial support being disbursed to any person under the project, pilot project, or similar initiative:

a. The city council of any city included in a proposed model community.
