A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring the state department of transportation to  
 2 conduct a study regarding expansion of United States highway  
 3 30.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 442

1 Section 1. HIGHWAY 30 FOUR-LANE STUDY. The state  
2 department of transportation shall conduct a study regarding  
3 the feasibility of and need for expansion of United States  
4 highway 30 between the cities of Cedar Rapids and DeWitt to a  
5 four-lane divided highway. The department shall report its  
6 findings and recommendations to the general assembly by  
7 January 2, 2002.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill requires the state department of transportation  
10 to conduct a study regarding the feasibility of and need for  
11 expansion of United States highway 30 between the cities of  
12 Cedar Rapids and DeWitt to a four-lane divided highway. The  
13 department is required to report its findings and  
14 recommendations to the general assembly by January 2, 2002.

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
