1 An Act relating to criminal offenses that require an offender to
2 submit to DNA profiling.

1 Section 1. Section 13.10, subsection 1, Code 2001, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. h. Any assault other than a simple
4 misdemeanor assault committed by an adult upon a child in
5 violation of chapter 708.

6 NEW PARAGRAPH. i. Lascivious acts with a child in
7 violation of section 709.8.

8 NEW PARAGRAPH. j. Indecent contact with a child in
9 violation of section 709.12.

10 NEW PARAGRAPH. k. Lascivious conduct with a minor in
11 violation of section 709.14.

12 NEW PARAGRAPH. l. Sexual misconduct with a juvenile in
13 violation of section 709.16, subsection 2.

14 NEW PARAGRAPH. m. Enticing away a child in violation of
15 section 710.10.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill increases the number of criminal offenses listed
18 in Code section 13.10 that require an offender to submit to
19 DNA profiling.

20 The bill provides that a person who is convicted of the
21 following offenses shall submit a physical specimen for DNA
22 profiling: any assault other than a simple misdemeanor
23 assault committed by an adult against a child, lascivious acts
24 or conduct with a child, indecent contact with a child, sexual
25 misconduct with a juvenile, and enticing away a child.
