A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the reimbursement of administrative costs of
2 an area education agency for services provided by the agency
3 under part C of the federal Individuals With Disabilities
4 Education Act, and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 462

1 Section 1. Section 256B.15, subsection 7, paragraph b,
2 Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 b. The area education agencies shall, after determining
4 the administrative costs associated with the implementation of
5 medical assistance reimbursement for the eligible services, be
6 permitted to retain up to twenty-five percent of the federal
7 portion of the total amount reimbursed to pay for the
8 administrative costs. This limitation does not apply to
9 medical assistance reimbursement for services provided by an
10 area education agency under part C of the federal Individuals
11 With Disabilities Education Act. Funds received under this
12 section shall not be considered or included as part of the
13 area education agencies' budgets when calculating funds that
14 are to be received by area education agencies during a fiscal
15 year.

16 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
17 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that a cap of 25 percent applied to the
20 amount of federal medical assistance reimbursement that an
21 area education agency (AEA) may retain for the administrative
22 costs of implementing reimbursement for eligible services,
23 does not apply to medical assistance reimbursement for
24 services the AEA provides under the Infants and Toddlers With
25 Disabilities Program (part C) of the federal Individuals With
26 Disabilities Education Act.

27 The bill takes effect upon enactment.

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Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REIMBURSEMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF AN AREA EDUCATION AGENCY FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE AGENCY UNDER PART C OF THE FEDERAL INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 256B.15, subsection 7, paragraph b, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

b. The area education agencies shall, after determining the administrative costs associated with the implementation of medical assistance reimbursement for the eligible services, be permitted to retain up to twenty-five percent of the federal portion of the total amount reimbursed to pay for the administrative costs. This limitation does not apply to medical assistance reimbursement for services provided by an area education agency under part C of the federal Individuals With Disabilities Education Act. Funds received under this section shall not be considered or included as part of the area education agencies' budgets when calculating funds that are to be received by area education agencies during a fiscal year.
