1 Section 1. Section 100B.11, subsection 3, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. For purposes of this section, "volunteer emergency
4 services provider" means a volunteer fire fighter as defined
5 in section 85.61, ~~or~~ a volunteer emergency medical care
6 provider or volunteer emergency rescue technician defined in
7 section 147A.1 who is not covered as a volunteer emergency
8 services provider under chapter 97A, 97B, or 411, or a reserve
9 peace officer as defined in section 80D.1A.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that beneficiaries of reserve peace
12 officers, as defined by Code section 80D.1A, are eligible to
13 receive a \$100,000 death benefit for the death of a reserve
14 peace officer in the line of duty. The bill adds reserve
15 peace officers to the definition of a volunteer emergency
16 services provider for the purpose of establishing eligibility
17 for this death benefit. The entire death benefit provision is
18 repealed effective July 1, 2002.
