13 This bill amends certain provisions of chapter 1189 of 2000
14 Iowa Acts that relate to the uniform computer information
15 transactions Act.

16 The bill amends the effective date, from July 1, 2001, to
17 July 1, 2002, for the repeal of a provision relating to a
18 choice of law clause in a computer information agreement,
19 contained in Code section 554D.104.

20 The bill also amends the 2000 Iowa Acts to provide that it
21 is the intent of the general assembly to consider the proposed
22 uniform computer information transactions Act in the 2002
23 regular legislative session, rather than the 2001 regular
24 legislative session.
