A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to establishing the state percent of growth for a
2 school budget year, and providing an applicability date.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 1, Code 2001, as
2 amended by 2001 Iowa Acts, House File 191, section 1, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 1. STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. The state percent of growth
5 for the budget year beginning July 1, 2001, is four percent.
6 The state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
7 1, 2002, is four percent. The state percent of growth for
8 each subsequent budget year shall be established by statute
9 ~~which shall be enacted within thirty days of the submission in~~
10 ~~the year preceding the base year of the governor's budget~~
11 ~~under section 8.21~~ annually in the year preceding the base
12 year. The establishment of the state percent of growth for a
13 budget year shall be the only subject matter of the bill ~~which~~
14 that enacts the state percent of growth for a budget year.

15 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY DATE. This Act is applicable for
16 the school budget year beginning July 1, 2003, and succeeding
17 budget years.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that the state percent of growth shall
20 be established by statute annually in the year preceding the
21 base year. Currently, Code section 257.8 provides that the
22 state percent of growth shall be established by statute which
23 shall be enacted within 30 days of the submission in the year
24 preceding the base year of the governor's budget under Code
25 section 8.21. The bill is applicable for the school budget
26 year beginning July 1, 2003, and succeeding budget years.
