A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the issuance of permits for the display of
2 certain emergency vehicles to motor vehicle dealers not
3 licensed in Iowa and to nonresident motor vehicle
4 manufacturers and distributors.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 322.5, subsection 5, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 5. A manufacturer, distributor, or dealer may, upon
4 receipt of a temporary permit approved by the department,
5 display new ambulances, new fire vehicles, and new rescue
6 vehicles for educational purposes only at vehicle shows and
7 vehicle exhibitions conducted for the express purpose of
8 educating fire and rescue personnel in new technology and
9 techniques for fire fighting and rescue efforts. Application
10 for temporary permits shall be made upon forms provided by the
11 department and shall be accompanied by a ten-dollar permit
12 fee. Permits shall be issued for a single show or exhibition,
13 not to exceed five consecutive days. A permit under this
14 subsection may be issued to a motor vehicle dealer not
15 licensed in this state only if the state in which the motor
16 vehicle dealer is licensed allows motor vehicle dealers
17 licensed in this state to display the vehicles described in
18 this subsection in that state in the manner described in this
19 subsection. A permit under this subsection may be issued to a
20 manufacturer or distributor who is not a resident of this
21 state only if the state in which the manufacturer or
22 distributor is a resident allows manufacturers and
23 distributors who are residents of this state to display the
24 vehicles described in this subsection in that state in the
25 manner described in this subsection.

26 EXPLANATION

27 This bill modifies a permit provision in Code section 322.5
28 to provide that temporary permits for the display of new
29 ambulances, new fire vehicles, and new rescue vehicles at
30 vehicle shows and exhibitions conducted for the purpose of
31 educating fire and rescue personnel may only be issued by the
32 state department of transportation to motor vehicle dealers
33 not licensed in this state if the state in which the motor
34 vehicle dealer is licensed allows motor vehicle dealers
35 licensed in Iowa to display such vehicles in the other state

1 in the same manner. The bill also provides that such permits
2 may only be issued to a nonresident manufacturer or
3 distributor if the state in which the manufacturer or
4 distributor is a resident allows a manufacturer or distributor
5 who is a resident of Iowa to display the vehicles in the other
6 state in the same manner.
