**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the display of one motor vehicle registration  
2 plate on motor vehicles twenty-five years old or older.

1 Section 1. Section 321.37, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code  
2 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 Registration plates issued for a motor vehicle which that  
4 is model-year-1948 twenty-five years old or older, and  
5 reconstructed or specially constructed vehicles built to  
6 resemble a model-year-1948 motor vehicle that is twenty-five  
7 years old or older, other than a truck registered for more  
8 than five tons, motorcycle, or truck tractor, may display one  
9 registration plate on the rear of the vehicle if the other  
10 registration plate issued to for the vehicle is carried in the  
11 vehicle at all times when the vehicle is operated on a public  
12 highway.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill allows motor vehicles that are 25 years old or  
15 older, or reconstructed or specially constructed motor  
16 vehicles that are built to resemble a motor vehicle that is 25  
17 years old or older, other than heavy trucks, motorcycles, and  
18 truck tractors, to display one registration plate on the rear  
19 of the vehicle if the other registration plate issued for the  
20 vehicle is carried in the vehicle. Currently, this allowance  
21 is made only for motor vehicles that are model year 1948 or  
22 older or reconstructed or specially constructed vehicles built  
23 to resemble a model year 1948 vehicle or older.
