A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the acceptance of voluntary goods and services
2 for the construction and maintenance of parks and recreational
3 facilities under the jurisdiction of a county conservation
4 board.

1 Section 1. Section 350.4, Code 2001, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 11. To accept goods and services
4 voluntarily offered to assist in the maintenance,
5 construction, or repair of infrastructure and facilities under
6 the jurisdiction of the board. All goods voluntarily given
7 shall be accepted subject to the plans and specifications of
8 the board and all voluntary services shall be performed under
9 the supervision of the board.

10 Sec. 2. Section 670.4, Code 2001, is amended by adding the
11 following new subsection:

12 NEW SUBSECTION. 16. Any claim based upon or arising out
13 of goods or services voluntarily provided to assist in the
14 maintenance, construction, or repair of infrastructure and
15 facilities under the jurisdiction of the county conservation
16 board.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill authorizes a county conservation board to accept
19 goods and services voluntarily offered to assist in the
20 maintenance or construction or repair of infrastructure and
21 facilities under the jurisdiction of the board. The goods
22 voluntarily given shall be accepted subject to the plans and
23 specifications of the board and all voluntary services shall
24 be performed under the supervision of the board.

25 The bill also exempts the county conservation board from
26 tort liability claims based upon or arising out of goods or
27 services voluntarily provided to assist in the maintenance,
28 construction, or repair of infrastructure and facilities.
