1 Section 1. Section 462A.44, Code 2001, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 462A.44 APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER.

4 The purchaser or transferee shall, except as otherwise
5 provided by this chapter, within five thirty days of the
6 purchase or transfer file a new application form with the
7 county recorder with a fee of one dollar and the appropriate
8 writing fee, and a transfer of number shall be awarded in the
9 same manner as provided for in an original registration.

13 Upon the sale of a vessel by a manufacturer or dealer, the
14 purchaser shall within five thirty days of the purchase make
15 application for registration and the purchaser may operate the
16 vessel without its individual identification number thereon
17 for a period of not more than ten thirty-five days after the
18 purchase date, provided that during such period the vessel
19 shall have attached thereto, in accordance with the provisions
20 of this chapter, a pasteboard card bearing the words
21 "registration applied for" and the special certificate number
22 of the dealer from whom the vessel was purchased together with
23 the date of purchase plainly stamped or stenciled thereon.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill amends provisions in Code chapter 462A relating
26 to the time period within which a newly purchased or
27 transferred watercraft must be registered by the new owner.
28 The bill expands the time period from within five days of
29 purchase or transfer to 30 days. The bill also makes a
30 corresponding change to the time period within which the
31 purchaser of a new watercraft may operate the watercraft with
32 a "registration applied for" card rather than an individual
33 identification number from 10 days after the purchase date to
34 35 days.

AN ACT

EXPANDING THE TIME PERIODS WITHIN WHICH WATERCRAFT MUST BE REGISTERED AFTER A SALE OR TRANSFER AND WITHIN WHICH WATERCRAFT MAY BE OPERATED WITHOUT AN IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 462A.44, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

462A.44 APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER.

The purchaser or transferee shall, except as otherwise provided by this chapter, within five thirty days of the purchase or transfer file a new application form with the county recorder with a fee of one dollar and the appropriate writing fee, and a transfer of number shall be awarded in the same manner as provided for in an original registration.

Sec. 2. Section 462A.48, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

462A.48 SALES BY DEALER.

Upon the sale of a vessel by a manufacturer or dealer, the purchaser shall within five thirty days of the purchase make application for registration and the purchaser may operate the vessel without its individual identification number thereon for a period of not more than ten thirty-five days after the purchase date, provided that during such period the vessel shall have attached thereto, in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, a pasteboard card bearing the words
