A BILL FOR

1 An Act prohibiting the loaning of money for gambling purposes
2 through a credit card or an electronic or mechanical device at
3 a licensed gambling facility.

1 Section 1. Section 99D.9, subsection 6, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 6. A licensee ~~may~~ shall not loan to any person money or
4 any other thing of value or permit a financial institution,
5 vendor, or other person to loan money on the licensed premises
6 on the basis of a credit card or similar instrument in person
7 or through an electronic or mechanical device including but
8 not limited to a satellite terminal as defined in section
9 527.2 for the purpose of permitting that person to wager on
10 any race. The use of a check or a debit card with overdraft
11 protection is not prohibited by this subsection.

12 Sec. 2. Section 99F.7, subsection 9, Code 2001, is amended
13 to read as follows:

14 9. A licensee shall not loan to any person money or any
15 other thing of value or permit a financial institution,
16 vendor, or other person to loan money on the licensed premises
17 on the basis of a credit card or similar instrument in person
18 or through an electronic or mechanical device including but
19 not limited to a satellite terminal as defined in section
20 527.2 for the purpose of permitting that person to wager on
21 any game of chance. The use of a check or a debit card with
22 overdraft protection is not prohibited by this subsection.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill prohibits the licensee of a pari-mutuel racetrack
25 or associated gambling facility or excursion gambling boat
26 from loaning or permitting the loaning of money for gambling
27 purposes in person or through a credit card or an electronic
28 or mechanical device such as a satellite terminal. The bill
29 does not affect the use of checks or debit cards with
30 overdraft protection.
