A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing a state poetry competition.  
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 2165

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 303.90 STATE POETRY COMPETITION.  
2 The Iowa state arts council shall establish an annual state  
3 poetry competition. The council shall consult with the state  
4 poet laureate in adopting rules and procedures for the  
5 competition.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill creates an annual state poetry competition under  
8 the direction of the Iowa arts council of the department of  
9 cultural affairs.

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HF 2165 - State Poetry Competition (LSB 2958 HH)

Requested by Representative David Johnson

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### Description

House File 2165 directs the Iowa Arts Council to establish an annual state poetry competition in consultation with the State Poet Laureate.

### Assumptions

1. One intern in the Department of Cultural Affairs would promote and administer the program at a salary expense of \$5,000.
2. Printing and postage to promote the competition and draw participants would cost \$1,500.
3. Expenses for individuals serving as judges in the competition would cost \$1,500.
4. Prizes and honoraria would cost \$1,000.
5. Other expenses, such as pins and ribbons for participants, would cost \$1,000.

### Fiscal Impact

The estimated General Fund fiscal impact of HF 2165 for FY 2003 and FY 2004 is \$10,000.
