1 Section 1. VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES -- STUDY --
2 RECOMMENDATIONS. The state department of transportation shall
3 conduct a study to review all annual registration fees paid
4 for vehicles operated upon the public highways of this state
5 pursuant to chapter 321 and to make recommendations to the
6 2003 general assembly concerning the need, if any, for changes
7 in the manner of assessing or in the amount of vehicle
8 registration fees. On or before December 1, 2002, the state
9 department of transportation shall file a report with the
10 legislative service bureau, for distribution to the members of
11 the 2003 general assembly, which contains the department's
12 findings and recommendations in regard to the study, including
13 any proposals to change existing registration fees for
14 vehicles.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill requires the state department of transportation
17 to conduct a study to review all annual registration fees paid
18 for vehicles operated upon the public highways of this state
19 pursuant to Code chapter 321 and to make recommendations to
20 the 2003 General Assembly concerning its findings and the
21 need, if any, for changes in the manner of assessing or in the
22 amount of vehicle registration fees. The bill provides that
23 the state department of transportation shall file its report
24 with the legislative service bureau on or before December 1,
25 2002, for distribution to the members of the 2003 General
26 Assembly.
