(COMPANION TO HCR 105 BY SIEGRIST)

A Concurrent Resolution designating January 30, 2002,  
as Iowa Insurance Day.

WHEREAS, the Iowa insurance industry, through its  
employees and agents, has made a historic contribution  
to the economic growth and strength of our state and  
nation; and

WHEREAS, all Iowans benefit from the financial  
protections offered by the Iowa insurance industry  
through the provision of mechanisms to insure the  
health, life, property, and retirement income of  
Iowans; and

WHEREAS, two hundred fifty-seven insurance  
companies are headquartered in Iowa; and

WHEREAS, more than 40,000 Iowans work in Iowa's  
insurance industry, with over 27,000 agents and  
brokers representing the insurance industry in every  
county in the state; and

WHEREAS, the yearly insurance industry payroll for  
its Iowa employees exceeds \$1.5 billion, 5 percent of  
the total payroll for all Iowa employees; and

WHEREAS, Iowa's insurance industry currently  
accounts for 4 percent of the gross state product, at  
over \$3.1 billion; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the Iowa General  
Assembly designates the day of January 30, 2002, as  
Iowa Insurance Day and invites the citizens of Iowa to
