A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to establishing the state percent of growth for
2 purposes of the state school foundation program and providing
3 an applicability date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 1, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. ~~The state percent of growth~~
4 ~~for the budget year beginning July 1, 2000, is four percent.~~
5 The state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
6 1, 2001, is four percent. The state percent of growth for the
7 budget year beginning July 1, 2002, is four percent. The
8 state percent of growth for each subsequent budget year shall
9 be established by statute which shall be enacted within thirty
10 days of the submission in the year preceding the base year of
11 the governor's budget under section 8.21. The establishment
12 of the state percent of growth for a budget year shall be the
13 only subject matter of the bill which enacts the state percent
14 of growth for a budget year.

15 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act is applicable for
16 computing state aid under the state school foundation program
17 for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2002.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill establishes a state percent of growth of 4
20 percent for purposes of the state school foundation program
21 for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2002. The bill
22 is applicable for state aid computation under the school
23 foundation program for the school budget year beginning July
24 1, 2002.

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**SENATE FILE 115
FISCAL NOTE**

A fiscal note for **Senate File 115** is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 115 establishes a State percent of growth of 4.0% in FY 2003 for purposes of the State school foundation program.

ASSUMPTIONS

1. Estimates are based on 371 school districts.
2. Special education weightings are assumed to increase by 4.0% for FY 2003.
3. Property tax valuation is assumed to increase by 5.0% in FY 2002 and 4.5% in FY 2003.
4. Supplemental weightings for shared pupils/teachers are assumed to increase by 10.0% for FY 2003.
5. Supplemental weightings for English-as-a-Second Language are assumed to increase by 11.0% for FY 2003.
6. At-risk weightings are assumed to remain the same as FY 2001.
7. Budget enrollments, supplemental weightings, and English-as-a-Second Language weightings for FY 2002 reflect the actual September 2000 counts, and special education weightings for FY 2002 reflect the actual December 2000 counts.
8. Budget enrollments for FY 2003 reflect Department of Education forecasts for September 2001 certified enrollment counts.

FISCAL IMPACT

Estimated State aid for FY 2003 is approximately \$1.867 billion. This is an increase of approximately \$63.0 million compared to estimated FY 2002.

Estimated total foundation property taxes for FY 2003 is approximately \$993.0 million. This is an increase of \$40.3 million compared to estimated FY 2002.
