1 Section 1. Section 303.2, subsection 2, Code 2001, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
3 NEW PARAGRAPH. k. Administer, preserve, and interpret the
4 battle flag collection assembled by the state in consultation
5 and coordination with the department of general services.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill specifically authorizes the historical division
8 of the department of cultural affairs to manage the battle
9 flag collection at the state capital grounds in consultation
10 and coordination with the department of general services.
11 Current law authorizes the historical division to manage
12 historical sites generally as defined in Code section 303.2.

FISCAL NOTE**

A fiscal note for **Senate File 164** is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 164 adds the administration, preservation, and interpretation of the Iowa battle flag collection to the responsibilities of the Historical Division of the Department of Cultural Affairs.

ASSUMPTIONS

1. No preservation work has been attempted.
2. Cost projections in the report entitled, "Iowa Battle Flag Collection: Recommendations for Stabilization and Use," dated June 2000, are accurate, with some exceptions.
3. Space for the preservation work and storage is available at no additional cost.
4. Not all of the staffing recommended in the report will be necessary.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated fiscal impact of Senate File 164 will be approximately \$120,000 in FY 2002, \$145,000 in FY 2003, and \$613,300 over the subsequent three years. The Governor has recommended an appropriation of \$120,000 from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund for FY 2002 for this purpose.
