TRANSPORTATION

1 Section 1. Section 322F.1, subsections 1 and 3, Code 2001,
2 are amended to read as follows:

3 1. "Dealer" or "dealership" means a person engaged in the
4 retail sale of equipment, if the person sells equipment
5 designed to be principally used for agricultural or
6 horticultural operations, lawn, garden, golf course,
7 landscaping, or grounds maintenance purposes, or raising
8 livestock.

9 3. "Equipment" means a device or part of a device designed
10 to be used for agriculture, horticulture, lawn, garden, golf
11 course, landscaping, or grounds maintenance purposes, or
12 livestock raising. Equipment includes but is not limited to
13 tractors, trailers, combines, tillage, planting, and
14 cultivating implements, balers, and irrigation implements, and
15 machinery, equipment, or repair parts used for lawn, garden,
16 golf course, landscaping, or grounds maintenance purposes.
17 Equipment also includes attachments to equipment. Equipment
18 does not include self-propelled machines designed primarily
19 for the transportation of persons or property on a street or
20 highway.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill amends Code chapter 322F to provide that dealers
23 of lawn, garden, golf course, landscaping, or grounds
24 maintenance equipment are treated the same as dealers of farm
25 equipment for the purposes of triggering the buyback
26 provisions of parts and equipment if a dealership agreement is
27 terminated as well as the other provisions contained in Code
28 chapter 322F concerning equipment dealership agreements.
