1 Section 1. Section 331.321, subsection 3, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. Except as otherwise provided by state law, a person
4 appointed ~~to-a-county-office~~ as provided in subsection 1 may

7 give the reasons and be filed in the office of the auditor,

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides that the removal procedure applicable to

AN ACT

RELATING TO REMOVAL OF COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISOR APPOINTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 331.321, subsection 3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3. Except as otherwise provided by state law, a person appointed to a county office as provided in subsection 1 may be removed by the officer or body making the appointment, but the removal shall be board by written order. The order shall give the reasons and be filed in the office of the auditor, and a copy shall be sent by certified mail to the person removed who, upon request filed with the auditor within thirty days of the date of mailing the copy, shall be granted a public hearing before the board on all issues connected with the removal. The hearing shall be held within thirty days of
