EDUCATION

1 Section 1. Section 299.1A, Code 2001, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 299.1A COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGE.

4 A child who has reached the age of six and is under sixteen
5 years of age by on September 15 is of compulsory attendance
6 age. However, if the child has reached the age of sixteen on
7 or after September 15, the child is no longer of compulsory
8 attendance age.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill provides that a child who has reached the age of
11 16 after September 15 is no longer of compulsory attendance
12 age. Therefore, the child's parent, guardian, or legal or
13 actual custodian is not required to cause the child to attend
14 some public school, an accredited nonpublic school, or
15 competent private instruction.
