1 An Act providing an enrollment adjustment for school districts  
 2 participating in an alternative high school program offered by  
 3 a community college under specified circumstances, and  
 4 providing an effective date.

1 Section 1. ENROLLMENT ADJUSTMENT. For the school budget  
2 year beginning July 1, 2001, a school district which  
3 participated in an alternative high school program offered by  
4 a community college for the school budget year beginning July  
5 1, 1999, which undercounted its weighted enrollment  
6 attributable to participation in the alternative high school  
7 program by fifty-five or more students when determining  
8 enrollment pursuant to section 257.6 on September 18, 1998,  
9 shall be authorized to adjust the enrollment count to reflect  
10 the revised weighted enrollment count in a report which shall  
11 be submitted to the department of education within thirty days  
12 after the enactment of this Act. The department shall forward  
13 the report to the department of management, which shall adjust  
14 the budget enrollment for the school district accordingly.

15 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of  
16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides that for the school budget year  
19 beginning July 1, 2001, a school district which participated  
20 in an alternative high school program offered by a community  
21 college for the school budget year beginning July 1, 1999,  
22 which undercounted its weighted enrollment attributable to  
23 participation in the alternative high school program by 55 or  
24 more students when determining enrollment pursuant to Code  
25 section 257.6 on September 18, 1998, shall be authorized to  
26 adjust the enrollment count to reflect the revised weighted  
27 enrollment count in a report which shall be submitted to the  
28 department of education within 30 days after the bill's  
29 enactment. The bill provides that the department shall  
30 forward the report to the department of management, which  
31 shall adjust the budget enrollment for the school district  
32 accordingly.

33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
