1 Section 1. INSTANT LOTTERY GAME -- RECREATIONAL BIKE
2 TRAILS.

3 1. The lottery commissioner shall develop and conduct,
4 pursuant to section 99E.9, an instant lottery game to benefit
5 recreational bike trails in this state. The instant lottery
6 game shall be conducted for one month during the fiscal year
7 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002. The revenue
8 received from the sale of the bike trails instant lottery
9 tickets shall be deposited into a special account in the
10 lottery fund. Notwithstanding section 99E.10, after the
11 payment of prizes and the deduction of moneys authorized
12 pursuant to section 99E.10, subsection 1, paragraphs "a" and
13 "c", the remaining funds in the special account are
14 appropriated to the state department of transportation to
15 carry out the purposes of chapter 465B. In funding bike trail
16 projects pursuant to chapter 465B, the state department of
17 transportation shall allocate the proceeds of the special
18 account equally among the five congressional districts in this
19 state.

20 2. Not later than six months after the completion of the
21 instant lottery game provided for in subsection 1, the lottery
22 commissioner shall review the conduct of the instant lottery
23 game and the game's result and submit a report to the general
24 assembly pursuant to section 7A.11A.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill directs the lottery commissioner to develop and
27 conduct an instant lottery game for one month during the
28 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002,
29 for the benefit of recreational bike trails pursuant to Code
30 chapter 465B.

31 After the payment of prizes and deductions made for the
32 gambling treatment fund and expenses of conducting the instant
33 lottery game, the remaining moneys are to be appropriated to
34 the state department of transportation and allocated equally
35 among the five congressional districts to fund recreational

1 bike trail projects as provided in Code chapter 465B.

2 Not later than six months after completion of the instant
3 lottery game, the lottery commissioner shall review the
4 conduct of the instant lottery game and the game's results and
5 submit a report to the general assembly.
