1 Section 1. Section 802.6, Code 2001, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 802.6 PERIODS EXCLUDED FROM LIMITATION.

4 1. ~~When a person leaves the state with the intention of~~
5 ~~avoiding prosecution, the~~ The time within which an indictment
6 ~~or prosecution may~~ information must be found or commenced
7 ~~within the time herein limited after the person's coming into~~
8 ~~the state, and no period during which the party charged was~~
9 ~~not publicly resident within the state is a part of the~~
10 limitation shall not include the time during which the
11 defendant is not present in the state.

12 2. The time within which an indictment or information must
13 be found or commenced shall not include the time during which
14 the defendant is a public officer or employee and the offense
15 arises from misconduct relating to the duties and trust of
16 that office or employment.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill relates to the filing of a criminal indictment or
19 trial information.

20 The bill provides that the period of time to file an
21 indictment or trial information to charge a person with a
22 criminal offense does not run unless the person is present in
23 the state.

24 Current law provides that the time to file an indictment or
25 trial information only tolls if the person leaves the state
26 with the intent to avoid prosecution.

27 The Iowa rules of criminal procedure specify that an
28 indictment or trial information must be found or commenced
29 within 45 days of arrest.
