Description

Senate File 2018 limits the payment of per diem to members of the General Assembly for the 2002 Regular Session to the maximum of 90 calendar days rather than 100 calendar days as currently provided for in Section 2.10, Code of Iowa.

Assumptions

- There are 18 legislative members from Polk County.
- There are 132 members from outside Polk County.
- Polk County members receive \$65 per day.
- Non-Polk County members receive \$86 per day.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of SF 2018 is a savings to the General Fund of approximately \$125,000 during the 2002 Legislative Session for Legislator per diem.

RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF DAYS OF PAYMENT FOR EXPENSES OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE 2002 REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND INCLUDING EFFECTIVE DATE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY PROVISIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. LEGISLATORS' PER DIEM FOR THE 2002 REGULAR SESSION.
