A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the transfer to the department of revenue and
2 finance of the duties of the child support recovery unit of
3 the department of human services.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. CHILD SUPPORT RECOVERY UNIT -- RELOCATION. It
2 is the intent of the general assembly that the child support
3 recovery unit be relocated within the department of revenue
4 and finance beginning July 1, 2003. The department of human
5 services and the department of revenue and finance shall
6 develop a plan for the relocation and shall submit the plan to
7 the general assembly and the governor no later than December
8 1, 2002. The plan shall include but is not limited to all of
9 the following:

10 1. A description of the restructuring of the department of
11 revenue and finance necessary to assume the duties of the
12 child support recovery unit.

13 2. A budget request, including the number of full-time
14 equivalent positions to be relocated, to cover the expenses of
15 the relocated child support recovery unit.

16 3. A listing of any changes in state law and rules, and
17 any federal limitations or requirements applicable to and any
18 federal approval necessary to allow for the relocation of the
19 child support recovery unit.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill directs the department of human services and the
22 department of revenue and finance to develop a plan for the
23 relocation of the child support recovery unit within the
24 department of revenue and finance. The bill specifies that it
25 is the intent of the general assembly that the relocation take
26 place by July 1, 2003. The departments are to submit the plan
27 to the general assembly and to the governor by December 1,
28 2002. The plan is to include a description of the
29 restructuring of the department of revenue and finance
30 necessary to assume the duties of the child support recovery
31 unit, a budget request to cover the expenses of the
32 relocation, and a listing of any changes in state law and
33 rules, any federal limitations or requirements applicable to
34 the relocation, and any federal approval necessary to the
35 relocation.
