3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 18A.6A CAPITOL -- PRESERVATION
2 OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORIC INTEGRITY.

3 1. A state agency, branch of government, or any other
4 entity responsible for a construction, remodeling,
5 restoration, maintenance, or other project in, on, or on the
6 grounds surrounding the capitol shall ensure that the project
7 preserves and enhances the dignity, beauty, and architectural
8 and historic integrity of the capitol.

9 2. A project described in subsection 1 may vary from the
10 architectural or historic integrity of the capitol if such
11 variance is necessary to comply with state or federal laws
12 relating to building accessibility or occupational safety or
13 health, to address life safety issues, or for other compelling
14 reasons. However, the state agency, branch of government, or
15 other entity responsible for a project involving a variance
16 from the architectural or historic integrity shall submit the
17 plans for such project to the capitol planning commission and
18 the capital projects committee of the legislative council for
19 review.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill requires a state agency, branch of government, or
22 any other entity responsible for a construction, remodeling,
23 restoration, maintenance, or other project in, on, or on the
24 grounds surrounding the capitol to ensure that the project
25 preserves and enhances the dignity, beauty, and architectural
26 and historic integrity of the capitol. Projects that vary
27 from the architectural or historic integrity of the capitol in
28 order to comply with state or federal laws relating to
29 building accessibility or occupational safety or health, to
30 address life safety issues, or for other compelling reasons
31 must be submitted to the capitol planning commission and the
32 capital projects committee of the legislative council for
33 review.
