4 compounds, or to dangerous or poisonous dyes or chemicals with
5 a federal occupational safety and health administration
6 material safety data sheet rating of greater than two.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill allows persons under 18 years of age to work at
9 an occupation involving the use of chemicals with a material
10 safety data sheet (MSDS) rating of two or less so long as
11 proper protective equipment is worn. Chemical manufacturers
12 are required by the federal occupational safety and health
13 administration (OSHA) to assess the hazards of chemicals they
14 manufacture or import and to provide information about the
15 chemicals on a material safety data sheet that rates the
16 hazards associated with use of the chemicals and recommends
17 whether there is a necessity for the use of personal
18 protective equipment during exposure to the chemicals.
