Description

Senate File 2328 sets the FY 2004 allowable growth rate at 2.0%. This will increase the school district cost per pupil \$91 dollars over the FY 2003 amount. The FY 2004 State cost per pupil will be \$4,648.

Assumptions

1. The estimated increase in State aid for FY 2004 is based on the appropriated amount in FY 2003 (\$1,784.1 million).
2. FY 2004 budget enrollments are estimated to decrease by 0.7% statewide. The estimated change will vary by district.
3. FY 2003 taxable valuations are assumed to increase 3.25% statewide and FY 2004 taxable valuations are assumed to increase 1.0% statewide.
4. FY 2003 and FY 2004 at-risk weights are assumed to remain unchanged from the FY 2002 level.
5. English as a Second Language (ESL) weights are estimated to increase by 11.0%, and the weight is currently 0.19. However, HF 2404 increases the English as a Second Language (ESL) weight to 0.22 and is pending action by the Governor. Approval of HF 2404 will increase the FY 2004 State aid amount by \$1.2 million.
6. Fiscal Year 2004 shared-time weights are estimated to increase by 10.0%, and special education weights are estimated to increase by 4.0%.

Fiscal Impact

The estimated FY 2004 fiscal impact of SF 2328 is as follows:

- State aid total of \$1,836.3 million, an increase of \$52.2 million (2.9%) compared to the estimated FY 2003 amount.
- Foundation Property Tax total of \$1,011.1 million, an increase of \$11.9 million (1.2%) compared to the estimated FY 2003 amount.
- A budget guarantee total of \$26.9 million (this amount is included in the total Foundation Property Tax amount) with 219 school districts eligible to receive.

School district estimates are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau.
