

1 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 104
2 BY STRUYK, DANDEKAR, MERTZ, and LUKAN
3 A Concurrent Resolution requesting the establishment
4 of an interim study committee to study state
5 expenditures related to economic growth.
6 WHEREAS, a number of programs are currently in
7 existence which are designed to foster economic growth
8 in the state; and
9 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has an interest in
10 ensuring that money used in economic growth-related
11 programs is used in the most efficient and effective
12 manner possible; NOW THEREFORE,
13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
14 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Council is
15 requested to appoint an interim study committee to
16 conduct a comprehensive study of all state
17 expenditures related to economic growth with a direct
18 impact on job creation or job retention; and
19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the interim study
20 committee shall study the efficacy of each such
21 economic growth-related program based on job creation
22 and job retention; and
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the interim study
24 committee shall make recommendations to the General
25 Assembly regarding methods to consolidate such
26 economic growth-related programs, eliminate or reduce
27 associated administrative costs, increase contact with
28 users of the programs, and increase the availability
29 of moneys under the programs.
