6 A Concurrent Resolution establishing a joint ad hoc  
7 committee of members of the Senate and House of  
8 Representatives to study emergency services in the

10 WHEREAS, emergency services are vital to the health  
11 and safety of Iowans; and  
12 WHEREAS, the organizational structure and  
13 governance of emergency services is complex, involving  
14 many units of state and local government; and  
15 WHEREAS, the funding streams available for  
16 emergency services are varied; NOW THEREFORE,  
17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE  
18 SENATE CONCURRING, That a joint ad hoc committee  
19 consisting of members from both chambers is  
20 established to study emergency services in the state  
21 during the Eighty-first General Assembly, 2006 Regular  
22 Session; and  
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the joint ad hoc  
24 committee shall receive input from the department of  
25 public defense, division of homeland security,  
26 departments of human services, public health, and  
27 public safety, including the state fire marshal, and  
28 representatives of emergency services providers,  
29 including but not limited to the Iowa Firemen's  
30 Association, Iowa Fire Chiefs Association, Iowa

1 Association of Professional Fire Chiefs, and Iowa  
2 Professional Fire Fighters; and  
3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the joint ad hoc  
4 committee shall expeditiously complete its study and  
5 issue findings and make recommendations regarding the  
6 governance, structure, and funding of the state's  
7 emergency services.
