1 An Act relating to criteria for reimbursement of owners of
 2 aboveground petroleum storage tank sites and including
 3 effective date and retroactive applicability provisions.
 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 455G.23, subsection 2, paragraph a,
2 Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. By ~~January~~ February 1, ~~2004~~ 2005, the aboveground
4 petroleum storage tank site was registered with the state fire
5 marshal pursuant to section 101.22.

6 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.
7 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect
8 upon enactment and applies retroactively to January 1, 2004.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill relates to criteria for reimbursement of owners
11 of aboveground petroleum storage tank sites.

12 Currently, the Iowa comprehensive petroleum underground
13 storage tank fund board may reimburse the owner of an
14 aboveground petroleum storage tank site up to \$25,000 per
15 site, but not more than a total of \$100,000 per owner, for the
16 upgrade or permanent closure of the aboveground petroleum
17 storage tank site provided certain criteria are met. One of
18 the criteria is that, by January 1, 2004, the aboveground
19 petroleum storage tank site was registered with the state fire
20 marshal. The bill changes the January 1, 2004, date to
21 February 1, 2005.

22 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies
23 retroactively to January 1, 2004.
