1 Section 1. Section 331.433, subsection 1, paragraph a,
2 Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. The proposed expenditures of the office or department
4 for the next fiscal year, including the amounts proposed to be
5 expended by an appointive officer or board for additional
6 employees to be hired.

7 Sec. 2. Section 331.433, subsection 2, Code 2005, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 2. On or before January 20 of each year, the auditor or
10 other designated official shall compile the various office and
11 department estimates and submit them to the board. In the
12 preparation of the county budget the board may consult with
13 any officer or department concerning the estimates and
14 requests and may adjust the requests for any county office or
15 department. The board may impose restrictions on the number
16 of additional employees an appointive officer or board may
17 hire in any given fiscal year and adjust the officer's or
18 board's request accordingly.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill gives the county board of supervisors additional
21 authority over county appointed officers and boards. Under
22 the bill, appointed officers and boards are required to submit
23 information on the number of new hires to be made in the next
24 fiscal year. The board may restrict the number of new hires
25 and adjust the officer's or board's request for moneys
26 accordingly.
