1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 80.41 DIVISION OF STATE PATROL
2 -- USE OF MOTOR VEHICLE.

3 A state-owned motor vehicle assigned to a peace officer
4 member of the Iowa state patrol shall be used by the officer
5 only until such time as the motor vehicle's odometer registers
6 seventy thousand miles. At such time, the vehicle may be
7 reassigned within the division to be used for purposes other
8 than patrolling the highways or may be disposed of pursuant to
9 section 8A.362.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill relates to the use of motor vehicles by the
12 division of the Iowa state patrol.

13 The bill provides that a motor vehicle assigned to a peace
14 officer of the Iowa state patrol shall not be driven more than
15 70,000 miles by the officer. When such vehicle's odometer
16 registers 70,000 miles, the vehicle may be reassigned within
17 the division to be used for purposes other than patrolling the
18 highways or may be disposed of at auction or by trade pursuant
19 to Code section 8A.362.
