1 Section 1. Section 321.210C, Code 2005, is repealed.

2 EXPLANATION

3 This bill repeals Code section 321.210C, which requires a  
4 probation period for certain drivers following a period of  
5 license suspension, revocation, or bar. The Code section  
6 requires that a person who loses the person's driver's license  
7 or operating privileges as a result of a moving traffic  
8 violation or an operating-while-intoxicated conviction must  
9 complete a 12-month probation period beginning immediately  
10 after the end of the period of suspension, revocation, or bar.  
11 If the person is convicted of another moving traffic violation  
12 which occurred during the probation period, the department may  
13 suspend the person's license or operating privileges for an  
14 additional period equal in duration to the original period of  
15 suspension, revocation, or bar, or for one year, whichever is  
16 less.
