19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill allows a resident who is a veteran, as defined in
21 Code section 35.1, or who served in the armed forces of the
22 United States for a minimum aggregate of 90 days of active
23 federal service and who was disabled or was a prisoner of war
24 during that military service, to purchase a lifetime fishing
25 license or a lifetime hunting and fishing combined license for
26 \$30. Current law allows only those who served in the armed
27 forces for 90 days or more and were disabled or a prisoner of
28 war to purchase a lifetime hunting and fishing combined
29 license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 13, Code Supplement 2005, is amended to read as follows:

13. Upon payment of the fee of thirty five dollars for a lifetime fishing license or lifetime hunting and fishing combined license, the department shall issue a lifetime fishing license or lifetime hunting and fishing combined license to a resident of Iowa who is a veteran, as defined in section 35.1, or served in the armed forces of the United States for a minimum aggregate of ninety days of active federal service and who was disabled or was a prisoner of war during that veteran's military service. The department shall prepare an application to be used by a person requesting a lifetime fishing license or lifetime hunting and fishing combined license under this subsection. The department of veterans affairs shall assist the department in verifying the status or claims of applicants under this subsection. As used
