1 Section 1. 650 Iowa administrative code, rule 10.6,
2 subrule 4, and rule 30.4, subrule 24, first unnumbered
3 paragraph, relating to the mandatory reporting of certain acts
4 or omissions by persons licensed by the Iowa board of dental
5 examiners, are nullified.

6 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This joint resolution, being
7 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This joint resolution nullifies portions of two
10 administrative rules of the board of dental examiners relating
11 to the imposition of licensee discipline. The rules were
12 referred to the general assembly for further study by the
13 administrative rules review committee at its meeting on
14 January 6, 2006. Iowa Code section 272C.4(6) requires
15 licensees to report acts or omissions that are grounds for
16 revocation or suspension of a license. The dental board
17 provisions nullified by this resolution require licensees to
18 report any acts or omissions which could result in discipline.

19 The joint resolution takes effect upon enactment.
