

1                   HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 34  
2           BY ALONS, BAUDLER, DE BOEF, and CHAMBERS  
3 A Resolution supporting the passage of the federal  
4    Citizens' Self-Defense Act of 2005.  
5    WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the United States  
6 Constitution states that: "A well-regulated Militia,  
7 being necessary to the security of a free State, the  
8 right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not  
9 be infringed."; and  
10   WHEREAS, the proposed Citizens' Self-Defense Act of  
11 2005 has been introduced into the 109th Congress as  
12 House Resolution 46 in order to support that  
13 constitutional right; and  
14   WHEREAS, the proposed legislation reaffirms the  
15 premise that citizens have a right to use a firearm in  
16 defense of self, family, and home; and  
17   WHEREAS, the proposed legislation would also allow  
18 persons whose self-defense rights have been violated  
19 to bring legal action against the person or entity  
20 violating such rights, including the United States or  
21 any state of the United States, in federal court; NOW  
22 THEREFORE,  
23   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,  
24 That the House of Representatives requests that the  
25 members of the 109th Congress promptly enact the  
26 Citizens' Self-Defense Act of 2005; and  
27   BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this  
28 Resolution be sent to the members of Iowa's  
29 congressional delegation.
