3 (COMPANION TO LSB 5685HH BY HUSER)

4 A Concurrent Resolution establishing a joint ad hoc
5 committee of members of the Senate and House of
6 Representatives to study emergency services in the
7 state.

8 WHEREAS, emergency services are vital to the health
9 and safety of Iowans; and

10 WHEREAS, the organizational structure and
11 governance of emergency services is complex, involving
12 many units of state and local government; and

13 WHEREAS, the funding streams available for
14 emergency services are varied; NOW THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF
16 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That a joint ad hoc
17 committee consisting of members from both chambers is
18 established to study emergency services in the state
19 during the Eighty-first General Assembly, 2006 Regular
20 Session; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the joint ad hoc
22 committee shall receive input from the department of
23 public defense, division of homeland security,
24 departments of human services, public health, and
25 public safety, including the state fire marshal, and
26 representatives of emergency services providers,
27 including but not limited to the Iowa Firemen's
28 Association, Iowa Fire Chiefs Association, Iowa
29 Association of Professional Fire Chiefs, and Iowa
30 Professional Fire Fighters; and
