1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 384.37A DELEGATION OF ENGINEER'S  
2 DUTIES.

3 When the estimated total cost of a public improvement does  
4 not exceed fifty thousand dollars, the city council may  
5 delegate the duties of the engineer as specified in this  
6 division to the city clerk or other public officer or to an  
7 architect retained by the city.

8 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 384.104 DELEGATION OF ENGINEER'S  
9 DUTIES.

10 When the estimated total cost of a public improvement does  
11 not exceed fifty thousand dollars, the city council may  
12 delegate the duties of the engineer to the city clerk or other  
13 public officer or to an architect retained by the city.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides that if the estimated cost of a public  
16 improvement does not exceed \$50,000, a city council or board  
17 of supervisors may delegate the duties of an engineer to the  
18 city clerk or other public officer or to an architect retained  
19 by the city or county.
