**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the senior living trust fund, providing for  
2 appropriation of the moneys in the fund, and providing for a  
3 repeal.

APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. Section 249H.5, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code  
2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. To the department of human services, a maximum of  
4 eighty million dollars ~~for the fiscal period beginning July 1,~~  
5 ~~2000, and ending on or before June 30, 2005,~~ to be used for  
6 the conversion of existing nursing facility space and  
7 development of long-term care alternatives.

8 Sec. 2. Section 249H.5, subsection 3, Code 2005, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10 3. a. Any funds remaining after disbursement of moneys  
11 under subsection 2 shall be invested with the interest earned  
12 to be available in subsequent fiscal years for the purposes  
13 provided in subsection 2, paragraph "b", and subsection 2,  
14 paragraph "c", subparagraphs (1) and (2).

15 b. Moneys in the fund shall not be appropriated in an  
16 amount in excess of the amount appropriated for the purposes  
17 specified in subsection 2, or for purposes other than those  
18 specified in subsection 2, until such time as the amount  
19 deposited in the fund, following disbursement of moneys under  
20 subsection 2, exceeds two hundred million dollars. At such  
21 time, moneys in the fund may be appropriated in an amount that  
22 does not reduce the fund balance below two hundred million  
23 dollars and only for the purpose of providing additional  
24 funding for the purposes of subsection 2.

25 Sec. 3. Section 249H.11, Code 2005, is repealed.

26 EXPLANATION

27 This bill provides for the use of moneys in the senior  
28 living trust fund. The bill removes the limitation period of  
29 July 1, 2000, through June 30, 2005, for use of the moneys for  
30 conversion of existing nursing facility space and development  
31 of long-term care alternatives. The bill prohibits  
32 appropriation of moneys in the fund in excess of the amounts  
33 specified for the purposes specified, or for purposes other  
34 than those specified, until such time as the amount deposited  
35 in the fund, following disbursements of moneys for the

1 purposes specified, exceeds \$200 million. At such time as the  
2 amount exceeds \$200 million, moneys in the fund may be  
3 appropriated in an amount that does not reduce the fund  
4 balance below \$200 million and only for the purposes  
5 specified.

6 The bill also eliminates the repeal of the section  
7 regarding nursing facility conversion and long-term care  
8 services development grants.
