1 Section 1. Section 455C.4, subsection 2, Code 2005, is
2 amended by striking the subsection.

3 Sec. 2. Section 455C.7, Code 2005, is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 455C.7 UNAPPROVED REDEMPTION CENTERS.

6 Any person may establish a redemption center ~~which has not~~
7 ~~been approved by the department,~~ at which a consumer may
8 return empty beverage containers and receive payment of the
9 refund value of the beverage containers. The establishment of
10 ~~an unapproved~~ a redemption center shall not relieve any dealer
11 from the responsibility of redeeming any empty beverage
12 containers of the kind and brand sold by the dealer.

13 Sec. 3. Section 455C.6, Code 2005, is repealed.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill relates to acceptance of empty beverage
16 containers by dealers of beverages. The bill eliminates the
17 ability of a dealer of beverages to refuse to accept any empty
18 beverage container if the place of business of the dealer and
19 the kind and brand of empty beverage containers are included
20 in an order of the department of natural resources approving a
21 redemption center. The bill makes conforming amendments
22 related to the elimination of approved redemption centers.
