2 making a penalty applicable.

STATE GOVERNMENT

1 Section 1. Section 137F.6, Code 2005, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. A food establishment covered by  
4 subsections 4 and 5 shall be assessed license fees not to  
5 exceed seventy-five percent of the total fees applicable under  
6 both subsections. In the event that a routine inspection of a  
7 food establishment licensed under subsection 4 or 5 reveals  
8 the presence of three or more critical violations, a  
9 reinspection fee of one hundred dollars shall be charged for  
10 each reinspection. Failure to pay the reinspection fee shall  
11 subject a food establishment to revocation of the food  
12 establishment's license pursuant to section 137F.7 and the  
13 penalty provisions of section 137F.17.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides for a reinspection fee to be charged in  
16 the event that an inspection of a food establishment that  
17 provides food for consumption on-premises or off-premises  
18 reveals three or more critical violations. The bill provides  
19 that the fee shall be \$100 per reinspection. The bill  
20 provides that failure to pay the reinspection fee shall  
21 subject a food establishment to revocation of the  
22 establishment's license and to the civil penalty provisions of  
23 Code section 137F.17.
