1 Section 1. Section 321.327, Code 2005, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 321.327 PEDESTRIANS' RIGHT-OF-WAY.

4 1. Where If traffic-control signals are not in place or in  
5 operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-  
6 way, slowing down or stopping if need be to so yield, to a  
7 pedestrian crossing the roadway within any a marked crosswalk  
8 or within any an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection, except  
9 as otherwise provided in this chapter.

10 2. A person convicted of a violation of this section is  
11 guilty of a simple misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled  
12 violation under section 805.8A, subsection 7, paragraph "b"  
13 "c".

14 Sec. 2. Section 805.8A, subsection 7, paragraph b, Code  
15 2005, is amended to read as follows:

16 b. For violations under sections 321.298, 321.307,  
17 321.308, 321.313, 321.319, 321.320, 321.321, ~~321.327~~ 321.329,  
18 and 321.333, the scheduled fine is thirty-five dollars.

19 Sec. 3. Section 805.8A, subsection 7, Code 2005, is  
20 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

21 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. For violations under section 321.327,  
22 the scheduled fine is one hundred dollars.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill increases the scheduled fine for failure to yield  
25 the right-of-way to a pedestrian from \$35 to \$100.
