1 Section 1. Section 321.182, Code 2005, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. Certify whether or not the applicant
4 is the owner of a motor vehicle. If the applicant is the
5 owner of a motor vehicle that is registered in this state, the
6 applicant shall produce the proof of financial liability
7 coverage card issued for each motor vehicle owned, as required
8 pursuant to section 321.20B, showing that such coverage is in
9 effect at the time of the application. If the applicant is
10 the owner of a motor vehicle that is registered in another
11 state, the applicant shall produce other evidence, as required
12 by the department by rule, that financial liability coverage
13 is in effect at the time of the application for each motor
14 vehicle owned.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill requires that every applicant for a driver's
17 license in this state must certify whether or not the
18 applicant owns a motor vehicle. If the applicant owns a motor
19 vehicle that is registered in this state, the applicant is
20 required to produce the proof of financial liability coverage
21 card issued for each motor vehicle owned, as required pursuant
22 to Code section 321.20B, showing that such coverage is in
23 effect at the time of the application. If the applicant owns
24 a motor vehicle that is registered in another state, the
25 applicant shall produce other evidence, as required by the
26 department by rule, that financial liability coverage is in
27 effect at the time of the application for each motor vehicle
28 owned.
