1 Section 1. Section 99F.7, subsection 7, Code 2005, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. It is the intent of the general assembly that employees  
4 be paid at least twenty-five percent above the federal minimum  
5 wage level. However, employees at a facility of a licensee  
6 shall be paid wages no less than one hundred thirty percent of  
7 the average county wage in the county where the facility is  
8 located, as determined by the department of economic  
9 development.

EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that employees at a facility licensed to  
12 conduct gambling games shall be paid wages no less than 130  
13 percent of the average county wage for the county where the  
14 facility is located. The department of economic development  
15 shall determine the applicable average county wage.
