1 Section 1. Section 331.904, subsection 1, Code 2005, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. The annual salary of the first and second deputy
4 officer of the office of auditor, treasurer, and recorder, and
5 the deputy in charge of the motor vehicle registration and
6 title division, and the deputy in charge of county issuance of
7 driver's licenses shall each be an amount not to exceed eighty
8 ninety percent of the annual salary of the deputy's principal
9 officer. In offices where more than two deputies are
10 required, each additional deputy shall be paid an amount not
11 to exceed seventy-five percent of the principal officer's
12 salary. The amount of the annual salary of each deputy shall
13 be certified by the principal officer to the board and, if a
14 deputy's salary does not exceed the limitations specified in
15 this subsection, the board shall certify the salary to the
16 auditor. The board shall not certify a deputy's salary which
17 exceeds the limitations of this subsection.

18 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY DATE. This Act applies to county
19 budgets for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and all
20 subsequent fiscal years.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill provides that the annual salary of first and
23 second deputies in the offices of county auditor, treasurer,
24 and recorder and the deputy in charge of the motor vehicle and
25 registration division shall be 90 percent of the applicable
26 principal officer's salary. The bill adds the deputy in
27 charge of county issuance of driver's licenses to the group of
28 deputies whose salary shall be 90 percent of the principal
29 officer's salary.

30 The bill applies to county budgets for the fiscal year
31 beginning July 1, 2007, and all subsequent fiscal years.
