**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to and making an appropriation for the remodeling  
2 and renovation of the sexually violent predators unit at the  
3 state mental health institute at Cherokee.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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APPROPRIATIONS

SE 2118

1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION -- DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE  
2 SERVICES -- SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATORS UNIT.

3 1. There is appropriated from the tax-exempt bond proceeds  
4 restricted capital funds account of the tobacco settlement  
5 trust fund to the department of administrative services for  
6 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30,  
7 2007, the following amount, or so much thereof as is  
8 necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

9 For the remodeling and renovation of the sexually violent  
10 predators unit located at the state mental health institute at  
11 Cherokee:

12 ..... \$ 1,500,000

13 2. Payment of moneys from the appropriation in this  
14 section shall be made in a manner that does not adversely  
15 affect the tax-exempt status of any outstanding bonds issued  
16 by the tobacco settlement authority.

17 3. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in  
18 this section shall not revert at the close of the fiscal year  
19 for which they were appropriated but shall remain available  
20 for the purposes designated until the close of the fiscal year  
21 that begins July 1, 2007, or until the project for which the  
22 appropriation was made is completed, whichever is earlier.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill appropriates \$1.5 million from the tax-exempt  
25 bond proceeds restricted capital funds account of the tobacco  
26 settlement trust fund to the department of administrative  
27 services for the remodeling and renovation of the sexually  
28 violent predators unit at the state mental health institute at  
29 Cherokee.

30 The bill provides that moneys from the appropriation shall  
31 be made in a manner that does not adversely affect the tax-  
32 exempt status of any outstanding bonds issued by the tobacco  
33 settlement authority and that, notwithstanding Code section  
34 8.33, moneys appropriated shall not revert at the close of the  
35 fiscal year for which they were appropriated but shall remain

1 available for the purposes designated until the close of the  
2 fiscal year that begins July 1, 2007, or until the project for  
3 which the appropriation was made is completed, whichever is  
4 earlier.

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
