**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act permitting cash prizes at annual game nights conducted by  
2 qualified organizations representing volunteer emergency  
3 services providers.

1 Section 1. Section 99B.8, Code Supplement 2005, is amended  
2 by adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 6. Notwithstanding any provision of  
4 section 99B.7 to the contrary, if the games are conducted by a  
5 qualified organization issued a license pursuant to subsection  
6 3 that primarily represents volunteer emergency services  
7 providers as described in section 100B.11, the sponsor may  
8 award cash prizes to any participant in any game of skill,  
9 game of chance, or card game lawfully conducted during the  
10 annual game night in an amount not to exceed one hundred  
11 dollars per game, with a maximum of five hundred dollars  
12 awarded to a participant for all games during the annual game  
13 night.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill permits a qualified organization that represents  
16 volunteer emergency services providers holding an annual game  
17 night to award prizes of up to \$100 to a participant per game  
18 and up to \$500 for all games conducted during the game night.  
19 A qualified organization is defined in Code section 99B.7 to  
20 include nonprofit entities, governmental organizations, and  
21 school booster groups.
