1 Section 1. Section 123.47, Code Supplement 2005, is  
2 amended by adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. In addition to any other applicable  
4 penalty, the court may order the state department of  
5 transportation to suspend the driver's license or nonresident  
6 operating privilege of a person who is of legal age, other  
7 than a licensee or permittee, who is convicted of selling,  
8 giving, or otherwise supplying alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer  
9 to a person who is under legal age in violation of subsection  
10 1, for thirty days for a first offense and for a period not to  
11 exceed one year for a second or subsequent offense.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill relates to the provision of alcoholic beverages  
14 to persons under legal age and driver's license suspensions.

15 The bill provides that, in addition to any other applicable  
16 penalty under Code section 123.47, the court may order the  
17 state department of transportation to suspend the driver's  
18 license or nonresident operating privilege of a person who is  
19 of legal age, other than a licensee or permittee, who is  
20 convicted of selling, giving, or otherwise supplying alcoholic  
21 liquor, wine, or beer to a person who is under legal age for  
22 thirty days for a first offense and for a period not to exceed  
23 one year for a second or subsequent offense.
